<b>Re:</b> Policies	Draft Sale and Disposition of Municipal Lands and Road Closure

## RECOMMENDATION

## BACKGROUND

At the April 14<sup>th</sup> Committee of the Whole Meeting, the following motion was passed:

Moved by Deputy Mayor Barr Seconded by Mayor Cameron

THAT the Committee of the Whole receive for information the report and the draft Sale and Disposition of Municipal Land Policy and the draft Road Closure Policy;

AND FURTHER THAT Committee directs staff to proceed with Option B as outlined in the report. Carried.

Option B as outlined in the report was the following:

**Option B**: Continue making the required changes to the draft Policies and bring the draft Policies to the May 12<sup>th</sup> Committee of the Whole Meeting for further discussion.

## **ANALYSIS**

The purpose of this review and new draft Policies is to ensure that the process of the sale and disposition of municipal lands, as well as the road closure process, is clear and easy to interpret for the public, for Council, and for staff to reference moving forward. The current By-law does not offer as clear an interpretation as possible, therefore staff have taken on the task of reviewing other municipal sale of lands policies.

The draft policies and the supplementary schedules are attached for further review. They have been reviewed by the Village's Solicitor and the Village's Planner. The only change that has been made since the first review on April 14<sup>th</sup>, is the highlighted section with the strike-through. This was brought up by the Village's Planner, as road allowances are one of the more common requests and recommends that they should be appraised for value and not exempt from that process.
